He is the Director of the Centre Suicide Research and Prevention and a professor of the Department of Social Work and Social Administration, The University of Hong Kong. He has published more than 300 papers in the areas of population health and statistics. He was a vice president of International Association of Suicide Prevention (IASP) 2009-2013 and an associate member of the Central Policy Unit (2009-2011; 2013-2014). He received the Stengel Research award for his contribution for suicide prevention in 2011; a Distinguished Alumni Award, La Trobe University in 2008 for his excellent research and service on population health especially in Asia. He is also a recipient

of an Outstanding Supervisor and Researcher of the University of Hong Kong in 2011 and 2009 respectively. His research interests are in population health, demographic transition, low fertility, public health approach for suicide prevention and program evaluation.
