In recent years, we have seen an explosion of data available for social scientific research. Harnessing the power of these data is a challenge for today's researchers. Some small surveys are difficult to generalize, while some large data sources have unknown or ill-defined population frames or have adopted non-comparable data collection methods. Given the wealth of information available, many researchers are combining data sources to address their research questions. Censuses or large-scale official data sources can be used to complement and extend the utility of small, non-standard, or untraditional data sources. This session will invite researchers who use one or more data sources in combination with large-scale census microdata. Researchers will highlight their topical research findings as well as methodological approaches or innovations useful for the analysis of combined data sources, including census microdata.
